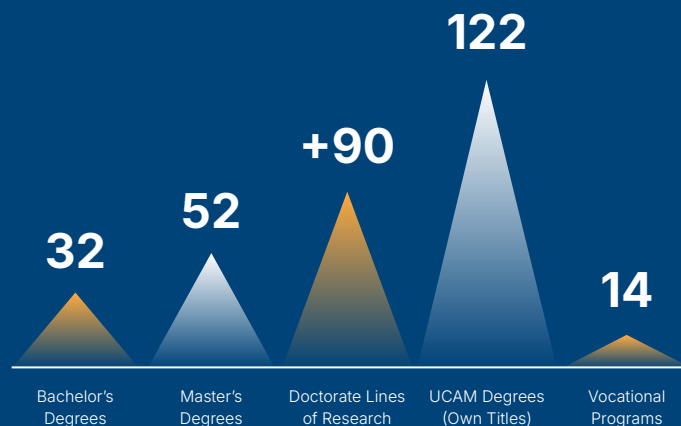

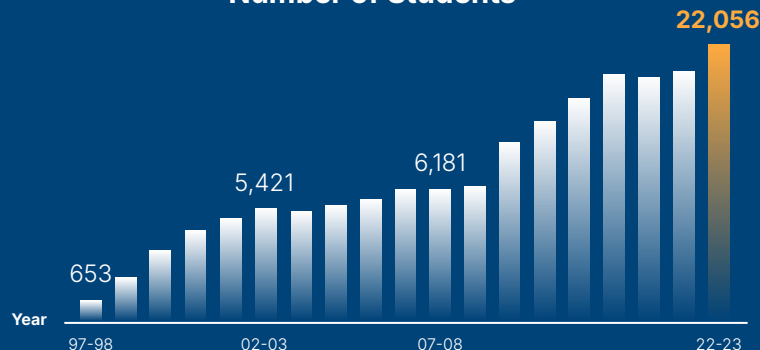

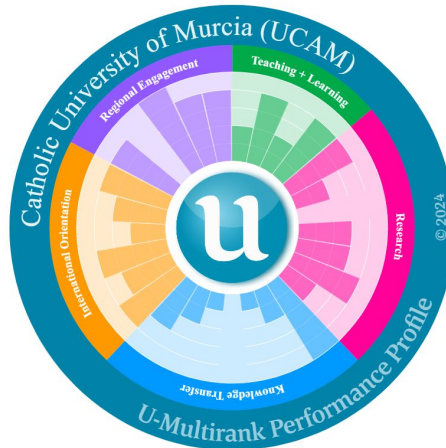

CAMPUS AND Location

Murcia Campus

Universidad Católica San Antonio de Murcia was established as an educational project focused on the **active presence of students, professors and other members** of the college community inside the campus.

The campus is located at the **Jerónimos Monastery** (18th Century building) with an area of over **225,000 square meters** that includes gardens, parking spaces and sports facilities. Together with its baroque church, it is declared a **Historic & Artistic National Monument**.

Inside the campus, you will find **well-equipped** and spacious classrooms, libraries, auditoriums, meeting and work spaces, computer laboratories equipped for multimedia and language classes. Furthermore, the campus has its own **television and radio broadcasting studios** that air in the Region of Murcia.

At only **4 km away from the urban center of the capital city of Region of Murcia**, the special environment of UCAM combines peace and calm with accessibility. The campus boundaries are not merely limited to the Jerónimos Campus compounds but is spread across the suburbs of Guadalupe with the **UCAM Sports Center** located within the **La Noria outlet shopping** center that is just 5 minutes away. Also, UCAM has several satellite campuses across the region for exclusive classes held in the summer.

Be-Soccer Condomina Stadium

Condomina Stadium is the university's football stadium, home ground of UCAM Murcia Football Club. Inaugurated in 1924, it is located in the heart of the city of Murcia, next to the Plaza de Toros (Murcia's bull-ring). This stadium has a maximum capacity of 16,000 spectators.

UCAM Sports Center

UCAM Sports Center is the first gym directly managed by UCAM's Sports Activities Service. With over 600m² of fitness space, five dedicated activity spaces totaling more than 1,000m², and extensive, fully equipped healthcare facilities available to all users, UCAM continues to strengthen its long-standing commitment to sports. Conveniently located on Avenida de los Jerónimos, next to UCAM HiTech, the center provides state-of-the-art facilities designed to support health, fitness, and well-being.

Sports Palace of Murcia

The Palacio Municipal de Deportes de Murcia is a sports hall used mainly for basketball and football. The site serves as headquarters for UCAM Murcia Basketball Team and El Pozo Murcia's futsal team. It has a total capacity of 7,454 spectators, extendable to around 9,000 extra tiered. It was designed by architect Miguel Belouqui and built in 1994.

Gaming House

The Gaming House is the main headquarters of the UCAM Sports Club, which is the result of the union of the Penguins Club and the UCAM International Sports Chair. Currently, the UCAM Esports Club competes in the best professional leagues, without leaving aside the amateur circuit, which is the basis for the training of our new talents.

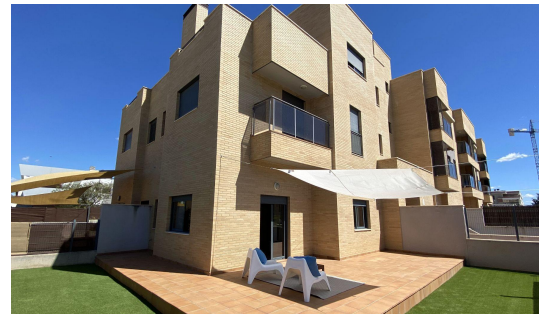

Option 1: Taxi to Murcia
(approx. €29 to city centre)

Option 2: Bus (Interbus) to
Murcia

From Alicante Airport

Take Alsa bus to Murcia,
available every 2 hours (€5.95)

From Valencia Airport

Take Alsa bus to Murcia, leaving
at 9.45 and 13.30 (€30)

From Madrid Airport

Option 1: Take Alsa bus to
Murcia, leaving Terminal 4 (€30-
€40)

Option 2: Go to Atocha Renfe in
the center of Madrid by Metro
(€2). Then take a Renfe train to
Murcia (€40-€47)

3. Travel to UCAM from Murcia

Option 1: by Bus

Take Latbus 44 A/B/D (available
every 15/30 minutes) or Latbus
UCAM
Directo to UCAM (€1.85)

Option 2: by Tranvia (tram)

Take the Tranvia (available every 10
minutes) to Los Rectores/Terra
Natura where you change to the
one with destination UCAM - Los
Jerónimos, available every 20
minutes (€1.40)
