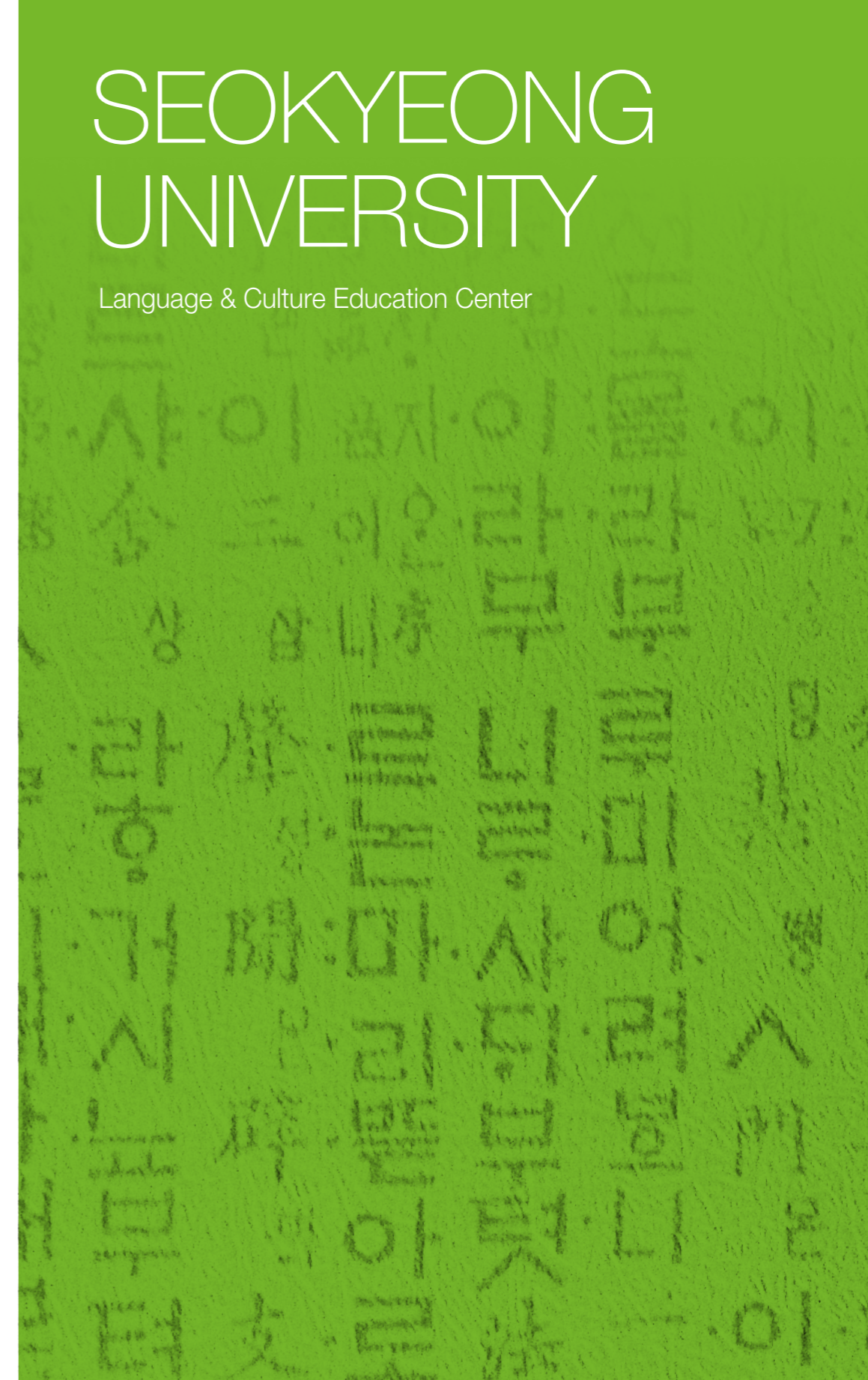

Criteria for Completion of Course

- Students must maintain an overall average score of at least 70% in the program.(for students score below 70% will be fail to go on the next level)
- Each semester's grades are calculated by adding up midterms, final exams, attendance scores, and others.
- Attendance must be at least 80%. The certificate of completion of course will not be issued if more than 4 absences are made.

ADMISSION AND ENROLLMENT

Qualification for Application

- Must be high school graduate (or equivalent) / with a higher education certificate

Enrollment Process

The registration process is as below:

* The original documents should also be submitted by post or visit.
Submitted documents will not be returned under any circumstances.

* If accepted, the university will send a letter of acceptance to potential students. After receiving this letter, students should

Tuition Payment

- Instructions on how to pay tuition fee will be provide to students after they have been matriculated
- Tuition fee must be paid to the school bank account.
- Tuition fee must be remitted with the name of the applicant.

Refund

- Before semester begins, students can get a full refund(except admission fee).
- After semester begins, canceling before 1/3 of the total class hours, students can receive refund 2/3 of tuition fee.
- After semester begins, canceling before 1/2 of the total class hours, students can receive refund 1/2 of tuition fee.
- After semester begins, canceling after 1/2 of the total class hours, tuition fee is non-refundable.

Documents for Submission (For non-Chinese)

1. Application form (including 1 photo)
2. A copy of passport (or residence card)
3. Official Graduation Certificate (diploma) of the last school attended
Documents in foreign languages other than Korean / English must be translated into English or Korean Apostille / authentication issued by Korean Embassy or Consulate
4. Official transcript of the last school attended
Documents in foreign languages other than Korean / English must be translated into English or Korean Apostille / authentication issued by Korean Embassy or Consulate
5. An original certificate of bank balances under the student's name (at least KRW 10,000,000)
If the certificate of bank balance is under the parent's name, the family relation certificate must also be submitted.
6. Family relation certificate
A copy of a family relation certificate should be submitted by Nationals from 21 countries.(announced by the Minister of Justice)
※ 21 countries : China, the Philippines, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Mongolia, Thailand, Pakistan,India, SriLanka, Myanmar, Nepal, Iran, Nigeria, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Ukraine, Ghana, Egypt, Peru
7. Insurance policies

Documents for Submission (For Chinese Applicants)

- Please refer to the Chinese brochure.

Insurance for international students

- Must apply for Korean private insurance (International student Insurance) or national health Insurance (6 months after entering Korea)
- Students who already have insurance in their home country should submit relevant documentary evidence to the Language & Culture Center.

Placement test

- The placement test will be conducted one week before classes begin.
- Placement test will be focus on WRITING and READING.
