Cork City

With a **population of 190,000**, Cork is a neat and compact city characterised by quaint, yet bustling streets packed with pubs, cafés, restaurants and shops.

The **city centre** is **lively and traditional**, with snug pubs, live-music sessions, busy food markets and a genuinely proud welcome from the locals.

You will find many contemporary buildings, bars and arts centres on both sides of the River Lee. The River Lee makes its way throughout the city centre to the busy Port of Cork which is shared by the city's rowing clubs, sailing boats and fishing vessels.

Take the opportunity while in Cork to **tour the South of Ireland** coastline and visit the nearby peninsulas of Mizen, Sheep, Beara and Iveragh, each with its own quirky identity.





The School

We aim to help students progress with their goals by giving them the English language skills to live, work, study, and travel in an English-speaking environment.

Our **native-English speaking teachers** are university graduates who have special qualifications to teach English as a foreign language. Many members of the teaching staff have extensive academic and general experience stretching over many years from teaching in Ireland and in other countries.

Recognised by ACELS, a service of Quality and Qualifications Ireland for English language teaching, we offer **superb quality courses.** We are also a member of Marketing English in Ireland (MEI), an association representing only the top English language schools in Ireland.



General English Courses

The course covers all of the English language skills – speaking, listening, reading and writing with a focus on communication skills in real life settings.

Classes are task-based, providing students with the necessary skills to manage their day-to-day interactions through English.

The course is student-orientated, placing the emphasis on student training, enabling more independence, and providing practical skills to apply their language learning long after they have finished their course.

Teachers monitor progress throughout the course and students receive weekly feedback and advice.

There is a maximum of 15 students per class. We offer all levels from Elementary (CEF A1) to Proficiency (CEF C2).

General English and Private Lessons

Examination Preparation Courses

Having an **official, recognised qualification** in English is an important part in a student's overall language learning.

An increasing number of employers and universities are looking for English language examination results.

At Cork English Academy, we offer courses preparing students for The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Exam.

IELTS courses are 6 weeks in duration and are run multiple times throughout the year.

Courses include preparation for Academic Reading, Academic Writing, Listening with regular timed examination practice as well as preparation and practice for the speaking exam.

Additional practice in areas of weakness for homework.

Academic Year/Work & Study Programme

The Academic Year also known as a **Work & Study** Programme is suitable for students from outside of the EU who need to **formalize their stay in Ireland for Immigration purposes.**

The **8-month** programme includes **25-weeks English language tuition** with the remaining 8 weeks as a holiday period.

Students will be registered to sit an official examination as part of their programme.

Students have the choice of the following 25-week tuition programmes:

- 25 weeks General English leading to the Test of Interactive English (TIE) exam
- 19 weeks General English and 6 weeks IELTS Preparation leading to the IELTS exam

Students are entitled to work during this programme which offers a great opportunity for **maximising your English language usage.**
