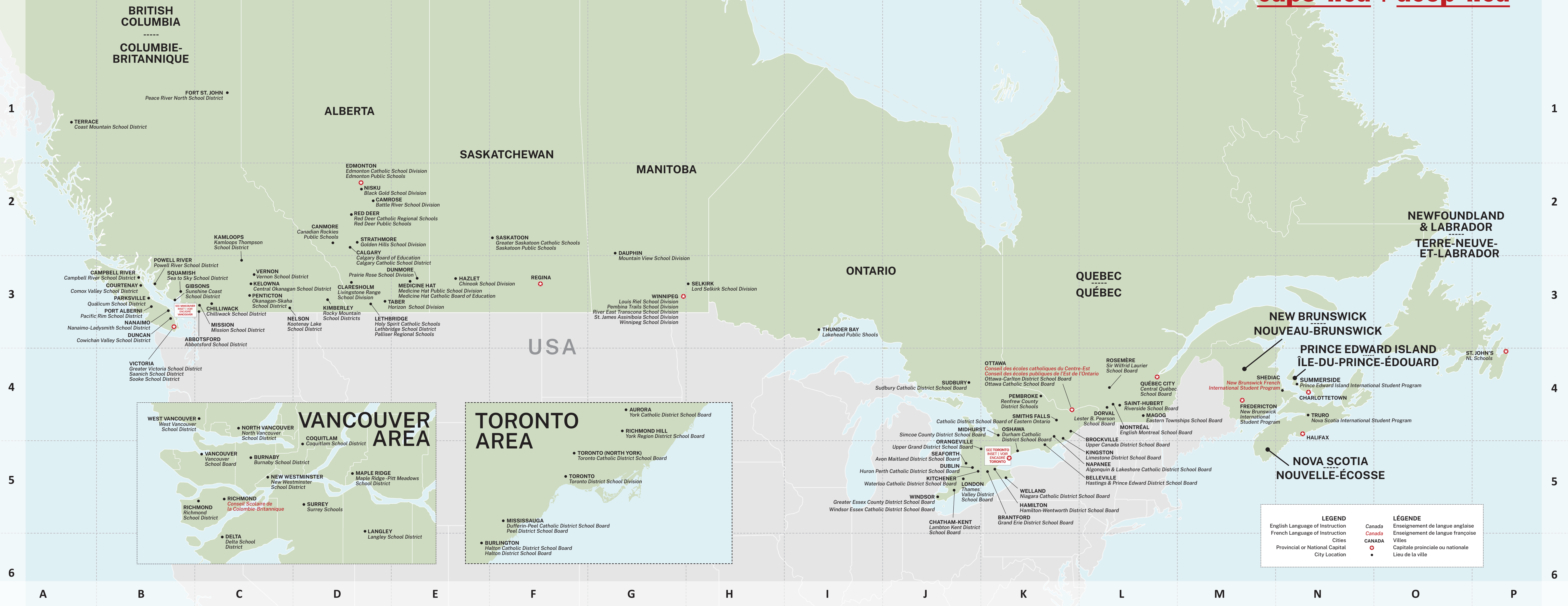

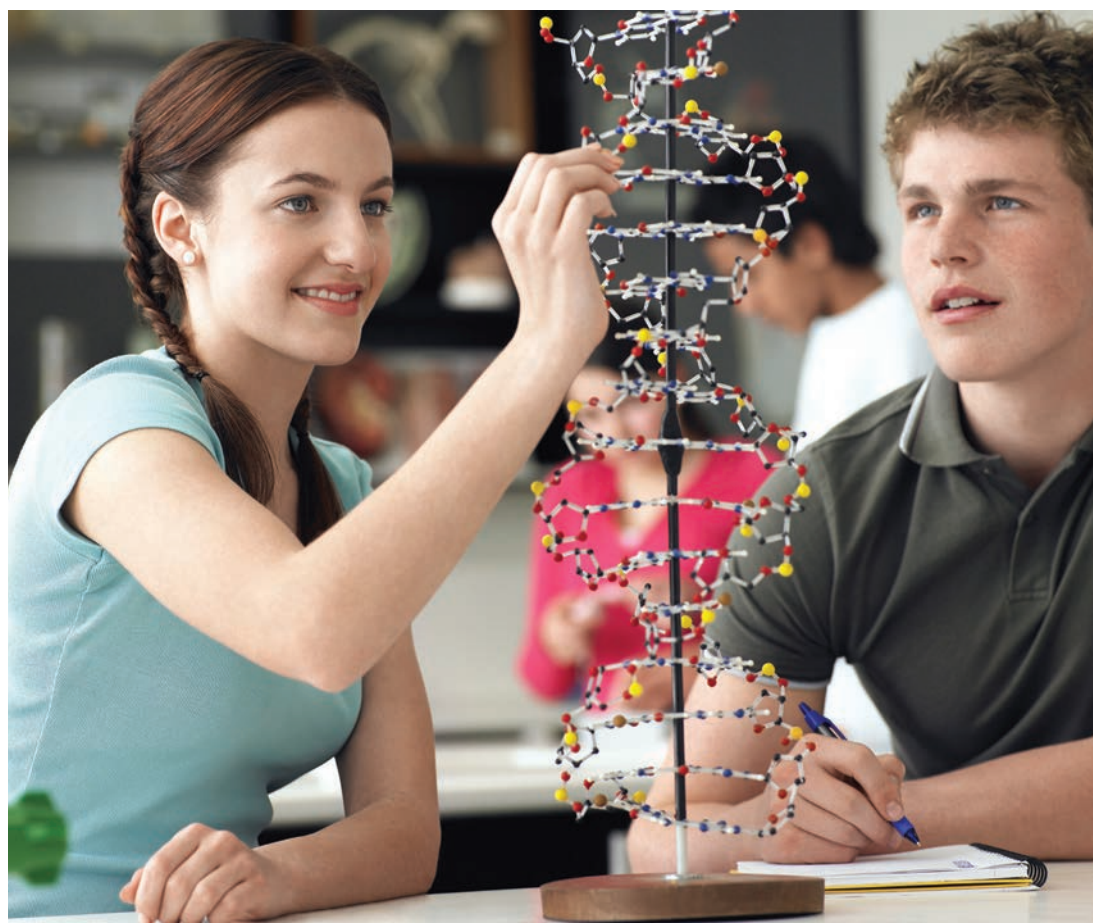
Association canadienne des écoles publiques – International

The Canadian Association of Public Schools – International (CAPS-I) is a national, non-profit association comprised of 130 public, government-funded school districts/boards from all 10 provinces. As a bilingual nation, students can choose to study in English and/or French. Each year, over 30,000 international students from 5 to 18 years of age study in Canadian public schools either in academic or shorter term ‘camp’ or cultural experience programs.

Our member schools set the standard for quality international student programs in Canada. Students have the choice to study in either English or French in our modern, well-equipped schools. International students are fully integrated into classes with Canadian students and taught by highly educated, government certified teachers. International students live with carefully selected and well-matched Canadian host families during their stay.

L'Association canadienne des écoles publiques – International (ACEP-I) est un organisme national sans but lucratif qui réunit 130 districts et commissions scolaires financés par le gouvernement, répartis dans les 10 provinces du pays. Le Canada étant officiellement bilingue, les élèves peuvent choisir d'étudier en anglais ou en français. Chaque année, plus de 30 000 élèves internationaux âgés de 5 à 18 ans fréquentent les écoles publiques canadiennes dans le cadre de programmes académiques, de camps éducatifs à court terme ou de programmes culturels.

Nos écoles membres offrent une éducation de qualité exemplaire au Canada pour les élèves internationaux. Les élèves ont le choix entre des études en anglais ou en français dans nos écoles modernes et bien équipées. Les élèves internationaux sont pleinement intégrés dans des classes d'élèves canadiens qui sont dirigées par des enseignants formés et agréés par le gouvernement. Les élèves internationaux séjournent dans des familles d'accueil canadiennes très soigneusement évaluées et sélectionnées au préalable.

- Les relations multinationales rendues possibles grâce aux programmes internationaux se traduiront par des avantages à long terme pour le Canada

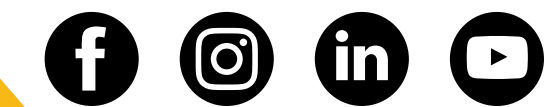
Énoncé sur l'antiracisme, l'équité et l'inclusivité
