












los angeles



How to apply

Our application process for international students is simple and, from start to end, they will have full support from the CLA team. The following documents and days are expected:

Your first step will be contacting a partner agency or a CLA representative to obtain the correct information and orientation about our school, documents, prices and process.

2 Complete the Application Form and send a copy of your passport so the CLA team can start your enrollment process. If accommodation is needed, you will also complete the Accommodation Application Form.

For F1 Students: complete the CLA Financial Form and provide a current Bank Statement (in English), must be filled out in addition to the documents above.

In 3 business days, you will receive your Letter of Acceptance (LOA) and you will be ready to start your journey abroad with CLA!

For F1 Transfer Students: in order to receive the LOA, students will need to pay the I-20 Fee (USD\$200). The LOA and I-20 Invoice will be sent in 3 to 4 business days.

- Initial Payment Required Tourist Visa Holders: \$150 (CLA Application Fee)
- Initial Payment F1 Visa Students: \$350 (CLA Application + I20 Fee)

CLA English levels and student placement

CLA uses a unique English proficiency level system that easily compares to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). Further details and a comparison are in the table below.

In order to be assigned to the appropriate class, students should follow these steps:

- When first accessing CLA's Portal, students are required to complete an online Placement Test.
- On their first day on campus, students will participate in an in-person Speaking Test.
- The teacher will assess the student's performance and place them in a class according to the results of both the online Placement Test and the in-person Speaking Test. This placement is based on the Assessment Test, with students grouped alongside current students based on their scores and the specific skills they need to develop.
