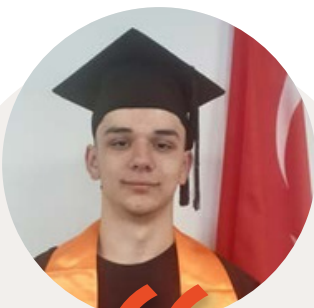

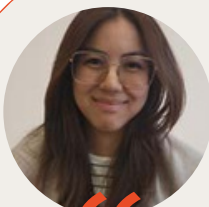

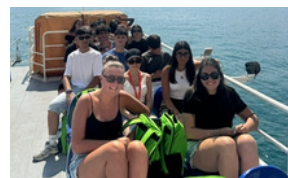

Course content

Your CELTA course at BSC will include at least 120 hours of contact between candidates and course tutors, as well as:

- Tutorial support and consultation
- Supervised lesson planning
- Six hours' assessed teaching practice per candidate supervised by a course tutor

Feedback on teaching practice

- Peer observation of teaching practice (i.e. watching the other candidates' lessons)
- Six hours' directed observation of lessons

You should also allow for 80 additional learning hours for course preparation, reading, research, assignment writing and lesson preparation.

Entry Requirements

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Minimum 18 years old
- Educated to a level suitable for higher education or university (A levels or equivalent)
- Competent in both written and spoken English (C1 minimum)
- Successful completion of an interview and a language awareness test



Online courses

You will need access to a computer (not a tablet), a stable Internet connection, headphones and microphone and a quiet place to study and deliver teaching practice.

For all part time courses you will need a computer (not a tablet) and a quiet place to study.

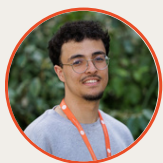

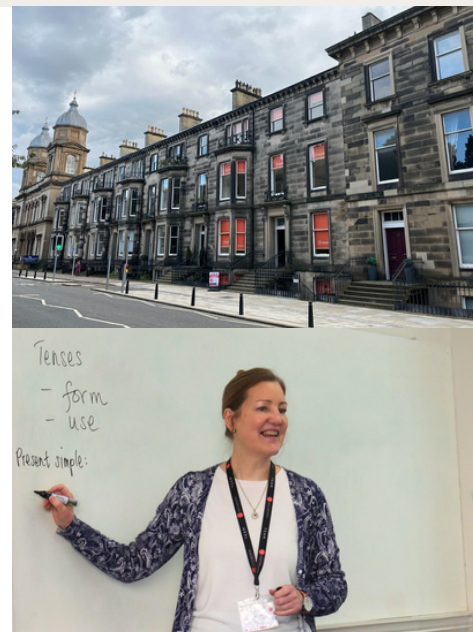

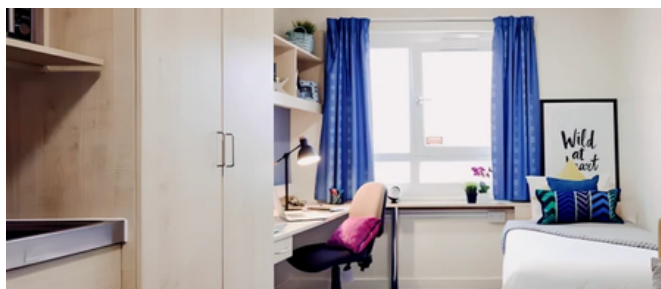
